Coronavirus

The parish is adhering to the Bishop's request to keep capacity at fifty percent. St. Joseph will continue to live stream mass for those unable to attend. Weekly masses will continue and the additional Spanish mass on Saturday.

Land Acquisition

Delinquent taxes were paid on the property that the parish is interested in acquiring next door. Rita Juergens has contacted the Chancellor of the diocese by e-mail concerning the purchase and is waiting for a response.

Religious Freedom Week

Eugene has posted information concerning Religious Freedom Week on the parish website. Are there any ideas promoting it? Suggestions were: put it in the bulletin, post on our Facebook page and maybe do something during the weekday masses.

Parish website

The parish website has been doing well and has been visited by over 1,000 people. This includes visits from other countries. Eugene will add current information about the coronavirus and what each parish is expected to do during the pandemic. Eugene will also continue to work on Flocknote.

Youth Ministry

The Youth group has not met due to the pandemic. Maria will contact students to help take down the old Stations of the Cross and replace with new ones when it is okay to do so. Confirmation will be moved to the Spring of 2021. No date has been set at this time. The current class will be combined with this coming year's class for a refresher course.

Camera System

The parish received a quote from Ace Audio for \$4,000.00 for a new camera system. The council determined this was too high. Ariel Buentello will seek alternative solutions that are more reasonable.

Maintenance

Parking Lot items
