From the August Officers and Council Meetings: GK Kenny Svrcek, the officers and a small informal group met to discuss finances, and how we proceed for now during the Corona Pandemic. We will be needing to generate some income as bills continue to come in. A BBQ chicken plate to go was held Saturday, August 15th, same date for the Mayfest Raffle drawing. 250 plates were sold and the drive thru went smoothly for the first try. It was a sell out by 12:15pm and customers were glad to get some KC cookin' and most asked when is the next one? We are thinking regular "2nd Saturday plates to go" for the time being. A thorough review of finances followed by the decision to do whatever we can to minimize our utility bills. Refrigerators and coolers are being emptied and shutdown, AC units are off. While we may need power and water intermittently, our goal is to keep utilities off as much as possible. We see many businesses like ours in the same boat.

- **SUPER BINGO** for the remainder of 2020 has been cancelled because of the ongoing corona virus pandemic. Although you may have heard that bingo halls can now reopen, for us social distancing and reduced crowd size is not an option. We depend on good crowd size to justify holding bingo. So, for now we do not know when bingo can resume.
- **OFFICER & COUNCIL MEETINGS** for the rest of 2020 (for now) will be held only on the usual first Thursday officers meeting night at 6:15pm. All members are encouraged to attend. There will no meal served, and a face mask is required. The meeting will be informal with social distancing precautions.
- SEMI ANNUAL AUDIT COMPLETED on Aug. 18th by the Grand Knight, Financial Secretary and Council Treasurer.
- **THANK YOU TO ALL** who helped at the last "BBQ chicken plates to go" fundraiser on August 15th. The cooks, the cake bakers, the servers, ticket sellers are all especially important to this effort. All 250 plates were sold (as per the plan) @ \$10 per plate for a total of \$2500. Extra donations were \$790 minus expenses \$465.12 for a profit of 2824.88.
- **FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEERS** for the sweltering August 21st delivery of (2.3 tons) food items were Harry Ormsby, Phil Konarik, Roman Razo, Jim Grametbauer, Pat Watson, Willie Barcak and Tom Alejandro. Charlie Watson called volunteers to remind them of the date and amount of food expected. The knights also help load other organizations vehicles as well. The Capital Area Food Bank truck also visited the KC hall parking lot Thursday, August 6th and Thursday, August 20th for "drive thru" distribution only. The KC hall was not open for restroom use.
- **COUNCIL 7014 EXPENSES** in August were for bills: Electric \$866.07, TXU outside lighting \$88.50, Trash \$143.51, Water \$106. Hall insurance \$1149.
