Mass on World Day of the Sick here at St. Joseph on Saturday, Feb. 11, 2023 @ 11AM

February 11 is *World Day of the Sick*, an observation introduced by Pope John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses.

We will have a mass here for all the sick and elderly of our parish and Father Pedro will be administering the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at this mass also.

La misa en la Jornada Mundial del Enfermo se llevará a cabo aquí en San Jose el sábado 11 de febrero de 2023 @ 11: 00AM

El 11 de febrero es la *Jornada Mundial del Enfermo*, una observación introducida por el Papa Juan Pablo II como una forma para que los creyentes ofrezcan oraciones por aquellos que sufren enfermedades.

Tendremos una misa aquí para todos los enfermos y ancianos de nuestra parroquia y el Padre Pedro administrará el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos en esta misa también.

The Vatican released Pope Francis's message for the 31st World Day of the Sick, celebrated every year on February 11th, liturgical memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes. The Holy Father's message is entitled: ***"Take care of him" – Compassion as a synodal exercise of healing.*** In light of the Church's synodal journey, Pope Francis invites "all of us to reflect on the fact that it is especially through the experience of vulnerability and illness that we can learn to walk together according to the style of God, which is closeness, compassion, and tenderness."

Pope Francis tells us in his Encyclical Letter *Fratelli Tutti* that "we cannot be indifferent to suffering" (68), and he proposes that we read anew the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37). The condition of loneliness and abandonment of the sick in today's world only "takes a moment of our attention, of being moved to compassion within us, in order to eliminate it." In seeking the help of another to care for the sick man, the Samaritan asks the innkeeper to "take care of him." Only with the help, courage, and innovation of others in a "face-to-face encounter" can we organize care for the sick in a spirit of fraternity and resilience. Many healthcare workers, family members, and community volunteers are daily witnesses of this accompaniment and caring compassion.

The World Day of the Sick is an occasion to pray for individuals who are suffering, and to find concrete ways to draw nearer to them.

Report from the recent meeting with representatives from the Diocese.

The recommendation regarding property taxes on the newly acquired property is to protest the current value which is too high. This will reduce the taxes for the current year. The following year it is recommended we apply for a ten-year window of no taxes while we plan and build on the land.

It was recommended we hire an architect to study our demographics and our overall needs. The architect is educated in making suggestions as to what we could build to serve our needs as we move into the future. A survey of the land will be a first step.

It was recommended we conduct a Capital Campaign to fund any building we propose.

Due to interest of buyers for the remaining 2 houses we are accepting offers online. Bids must be in by February 27th. We will only consider bids that show proof of a contract with a moving company to ensure that the houses will be moved within a reasonable time.

Informe de la reciente reunión con representantes de la Diócesis.

La recomendación con respecto a los impuestos a la propiedad sobre la propiedad recién adquirida es protestar por el valor actual que es demasiado alto. Esto reducirá los impuestos para el año en curso. Al año siguiente, se recomienda que solicitemos una ventana de diez años sin impuestos mientras planificamos y construimos en el terreno.

Se recomendó que contratáramos a un arquitecto para estudiar nuestra demografía y nuestras necesidades generales. El arquitecto está educado para hacer sugerencias sobre lo que podríamos construir para satisfacer nuestras necesidades a medida que avanzamos hacia el futuro. Un estudio de la tierra será un primer paso.

Se recomendó que realicemos una Campaña de Capital para financiar cualquier edificio que propongamos.

Debido al interés de los compradores por las 2 casas restantes, estamos aceptando ofertas en línea. Las ofertas deben estar antes del 27 de febrero. Solo consideraremos ofertas que muestren prueba de un contrato con una empresa de mudanzas para garantizar que las casas se muden dentro de un tiempo razonable.

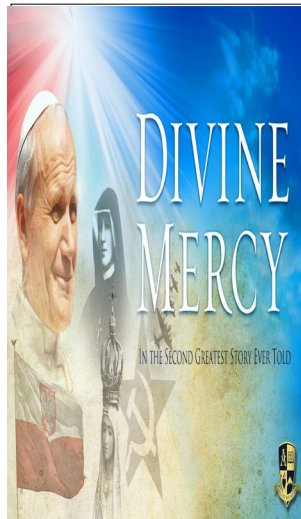

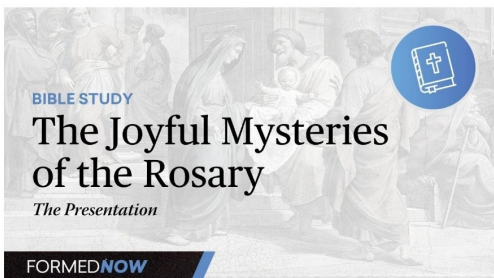

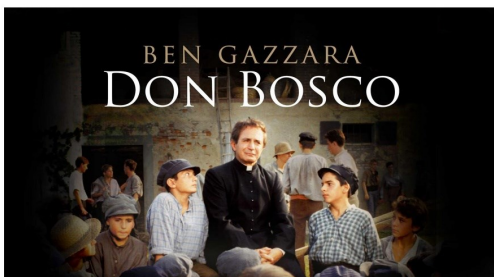

A Year of EUCHARIS- TIC MARTYRS

PAUL COMTOIS (1966 AD)

... Having been assured that all his family and guests had escaped the inferno, the seventy-year-old **Paul Comtois** returned to the private chapel in which he visited the Lord every evening before bed to save the Blessed Sacrament from the desecrating fire. He reached the chapel, already engulfed in flames, but managed to make it to the tabernacle and remove the pyx containing the Body of Christ.

Leaving the chapel, he descended the staircase which collapsed about him, and the Lieutenant-Governor was burned alive in the inferno. The Eucharist, however, was saved from destruction by Paul's body.

Paul Comtois has been compared to St. Tarcisus for his willingness to die to protect the Blessed Sacrament.



... Después de estar seguro de que toda su familia e invitados habían escapado del infierno, Paul Comtois, de setenta años, regresó a la capilla privada en la que visitaba al Señor todas las noches antes de acostarse para salvar al Santísimo Sacramento del fuego profanador. Llegó a la capilla, ya envuelta en llamas, pero logró llegar al sagrario y sacar la píxide que contenía el Cuerpo de Cristo.

Al salir de la capilla, descendió la escalera que se derrumbó a su alrededor, y el teniente gobernador fue quemado vivo en el infierno. La Eucaristía, sin embargo, fue salvada de la destrucción por el cuerpo de Pablo.

Se ha comparado a Paul Comtois con San Tarsicio por su disposición a morir para proteger el Santísimo Sacramento.

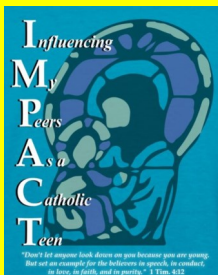
