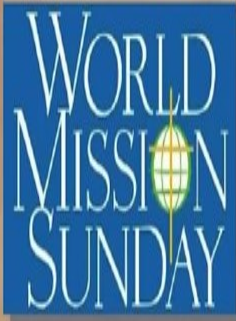

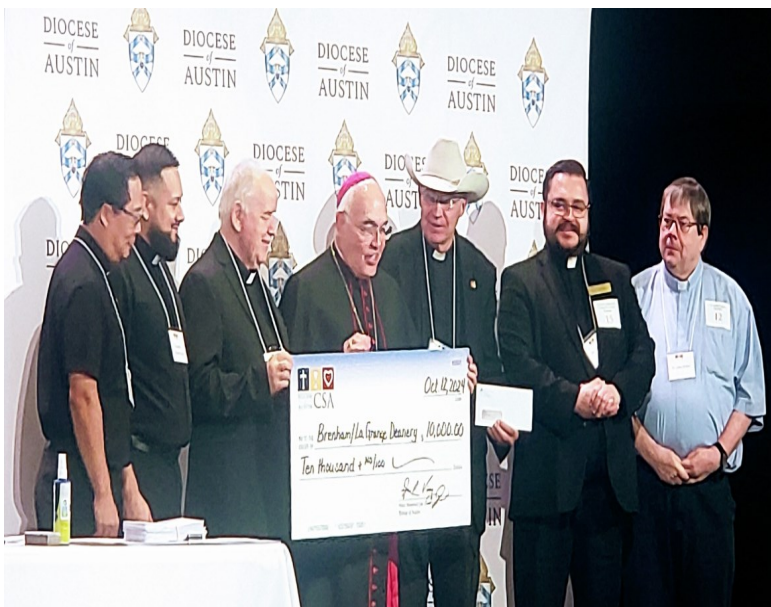

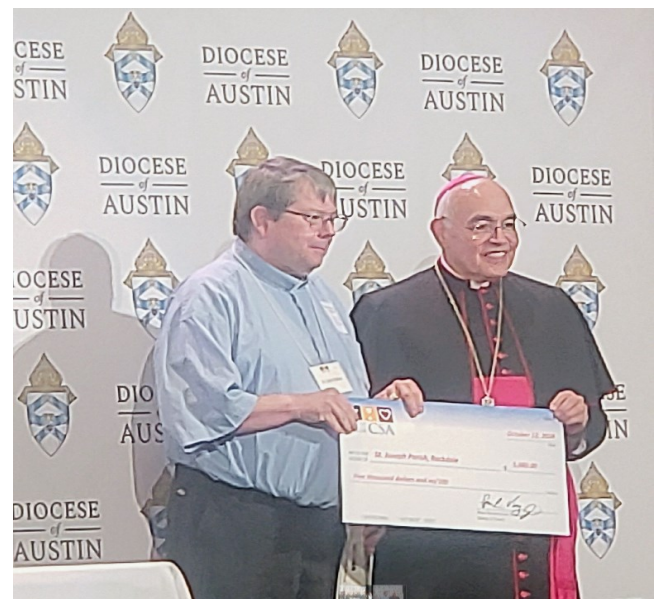

St. Joseph was one of the 27 parishes that were awarded \$5,000 for achieving all seven of our CSA goals last year. We did this by 1) achieving our CSA 2023-2024 goal, 2) achieving our CSA 2023-2024 challenge goal, 3) our deanery achieved its goal, 4) we had a year over year increase in the number of gifts, 5) Our priest attended the Priest Luncheon, 6) we showed the CSA video at all masses, 7) and we met year over year increase in family participation rate from the prior year. This was a team effort! Not only do we have to meet our goals, but so does our deanery. This is not an easy task to do, but thanks to everyone doing their part, we did it! We did this also with only 54.50% participation here at St. Joseph! We are hoping to increase our participation rate to 100% this year! Again, thank you to all the parishioners who helped us achieve our goal last year. Let's do it again this year!

No solo tenemos que cumplir nuestras metas, sino también nuestro decanato. Esta no es una tarea fácil de hacer, pero gracias a todos los que hicieron su parte, ¡lo logramos! ¡Hicimos esto también con solo un 54.50% de participación aquí en San Jose! ¡Esperamos aumentar nuestra tasa de participación al 100% este año! Una vez más, gracias a todos los feligreses que nos ayudaron a lograr nuestra meta el año pasado. ¡Hagámoslo de nuevo este año!

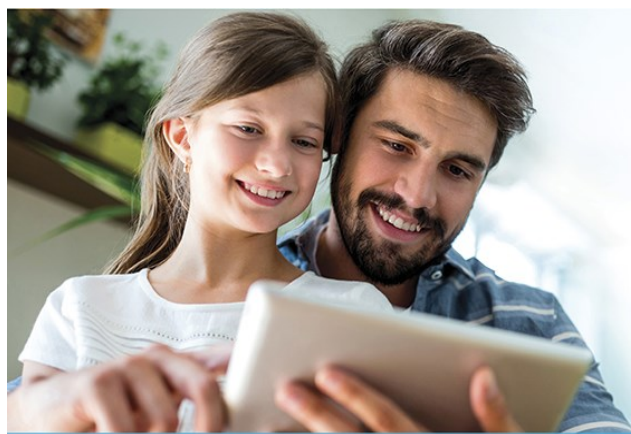


Novena to the Mother of God

Once, the confessor told me to pray for his intention, and I began a novena to the Mother of God. This novena consisted in the prayer, "Hail, Holy Queen," recited nine times. Toward the end of the novena, I saw the Mother of God with the Infant Jesus in Her arms, and I also saw my confessor kneeling at Her feet and talking with Her. I did not understand what he was saying to Her, because I was busy talking with the Infant Jesus, who came down from His Mother's arms and approached me. I could not stop wondering at His beauty. I heard a few of the words that the Mother of God spoke to him (my confessor) but not everything. The words were: "I am not only the Queen of Heaven, but also the Mother of Mercy and your Mother". And at that moment She stretched out her right hand, in which She was clasping her mantle, and She covered the priest with it. At that moment, the vision vanished. (Diary 330)

Novena a la Madre de Dios

Una vez, el confesor me dijo que rezara por su intención, y comencé una novena a la Madre de Dios. Esta novena consistía en la oración "Salve, Santa Reina", recitada nueve veces. Hacia el final de la novena, vi a la Madre de Dios con el Niño Jesús en sus brazos, y también vi a mi confesor arrodillado a sus pies y hablando con Ella. Yo no entendía lo que le decía, porque estaba ocupado hablando con el Niño Jesús, que bajó de los brazos de su Madre y se acercó a mí. No podía dejar de maravillarme ante su belleza. Escuché algunas de las palabras que la Madre de Dios le dijo a él (mi confesor) pero no todo. Las palabras fueron: "No solo soy la Reina del Cielo, sino también la Madre de la Misericordia y vuestra Madre". Y en ese momento extendió su mano derecha, en la que estaba sujeta su manto, y cubrió al sacerdote con él. En ese momento, la visión se desvaneció. (Diario 330)
