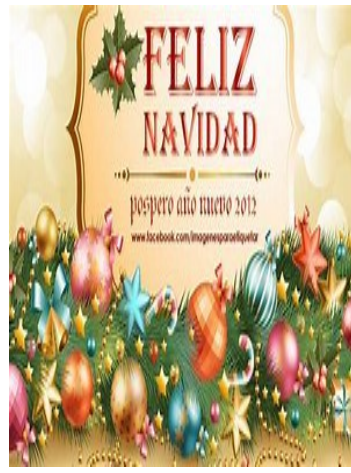

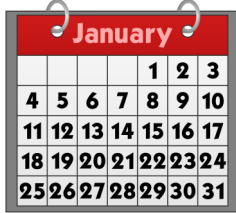



Dec. 21-22, Fourth Sunday of Advent

Bishop Vásquez asks all to pray in preparation for Jubilee 2025

Pope Francis has officially proclaimed 2025 as a Jubilee year for the Catholic Church.

The theme for the Jubilee is Pilgrims of Hope.

In a world marked by war, divisions, environmental destruction and economic challenges, hope seem hard to come by, the Holy Father said. But “Christian hope does not deceive or disappoint because it is grounded in the certainty that nothing and no one may ever separate us from God’s love,” he said.

In a message to the faithful, Bishop Joe Vásquez said the Jubilee Year is a time of great spiritual and social significance in the life of Christ.

“It will be a time to pray for a world suffering the impacts of war, poverty, hunger, and the climate crisis,” Bishop Vásquez said.

The Jubilee Year will begin with the opening of the Holy Doors of St. Peter’s Basilica on Christmas Eve of this year. The Holy Door will close on the feast of the Epiphany, Jan. 6, 2026.

The Vatican is expecting millions to travel to Rome in celebration of the Jubilee. During the Jubilee, Catholics who pilgrimage to Rome and enter the Holy Doors or those who undertake a work of mercy or an act of penance, may receive a plenary indulgence if they also go to confession, receive Communion, and pray for the intentions of the pope.

In these months leading up to the Year of Jubilee, Bishop Joe Vásquez is asking the faithful to spend time with the Lord in daily prayer.

Mass Intention Policy Effective January 1, 2025

Mass Intentions

On February 22, 1991, the Congregation for the Clergy allowed priests to accept multiple Mass intentions under certain conditions. Looking at the desire of many of St. Joseph Parish members, I have decided to institute the decree beginning January 1, 2025.

According to the decree, the multiple Mass intentions can only be done on two days a week. The days will be Saturday and Sunday. However, one of the three Masses must be for the intentions for the parish, so that Mass will not accept any other intentions.

We will limit the number of intentions to 7, except on the following days: Easter, Mothers' Day, Father's Day, All Souls' Day, and Christmas. On these days there will be no limit to the number of intentions accepted. We will no longer read the names at Mass, since they are printed in the Sunday bulletin.

If you have already scheduled a Mass for the year, you may come and change it to a Sunday, unless there are seven intentions, and it is not one of the exempt Sundays. I hope this will allow everyone to be able to have Masses prayed for their loved ones and to be present for the Mass.

Intenciones de la misa

El 22 de febrero de 1991, la Congregación para el Clero permitió a los sacerdotes aceptar múltiples intenciones de Misa bajo ciertas condiciones. Mirando el deseo de muchos de los miembros de la parroquia de San José, he decidido instituir el decreto a partir del 1 de enero de 2025.

De acuerdo con el decreto, las múltiples intenciones de misa solo se pueden hacer dos días a la semana. Los días serán sábado y domingo. Sin embargo, una de las tres Misas debe ser para las intenciones de la parroquia, de modo que la Misa no acepte ninguna otra intención.

Limitaremos el número de intenciones a 7, excepto en los siguientes días: la Pascua, Día de las Madres, Día de los Padres, Día de los Fieles Difuntos y la Navidad. En estos días no habrá límite en el número de intenciones aceptadas. Ya no leeremos los nombres en la Misa, ya que están impresos en el boletín dominical.

Si ya has programado una misa para el año, puedes venir y cambiarla a domingo, a menos que haya siete intenciones, y no sea uno de los domingos exentos. Espero que esto permita que todos puedan tener Misas rezadas por sus seres queridos y estar presentes en la Misa.

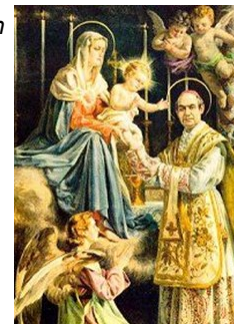

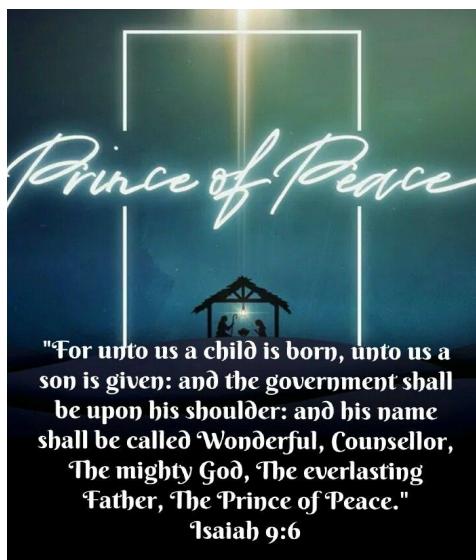

Bishop Vásquez asks all to pray in preparation for Jubilee 2025

Pope Francis has officially proclaimed 2025 as a Jubilee year for the Catholic Church.



The theme for the Jubilee is Pilgrims of Hope.

In a world marked by war, divisions, environmental destruction and economic challenges, hope can seem hard to come by, the Holy Father said. But “Christian hope does not deceive or disappoint because it is grounded in the certainty that nothing and no one may ever separate us from God's love,” he said.

In a message to the faithful, Bishop Joe Vásquez said the Jubilee Year is a time of great spiritual, ecclesial and social significance in the life of Christ.

“It will be a time to pray for a world suffering the impacts of war, poverty, hunger, and the climate crisis,” Bishop Vásquez said.

The Jubilee Year will begin with the opening of the Holy Doors of St. Peter’s Basilica on Christmas Eve of this year. The Holy Door will close on the feast of the Epiphany, Jan. 6, 2026.

The Vatican is expecting millions to travel to Rome in celebration of the Jubilee. During the Jubilee, Catholics who pilgrimage to Rome and enter the Holy Doors or those who undertake a work of mercy or an act of penance, may receive a plenary indulgence if they also go to confession, receive Communion, and pray for the intentions of the pope.

In these months leading up to the Year of Jubilee, Bishop Joe Vásquez is asking the faithful to spend time with the Lord in daily prayer.

“Let us offer prayers in thanksgiving for what the Lord has done for us – and the gifts he has yet to impart -- for our own personal intentions, for the intentions of our families, friends, and coworkers; and especially prayers for our wounded world as it is only through Christ that we find solace through his redeeming love,” the bishop said in a video released in May.

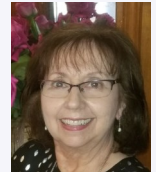

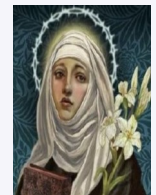
