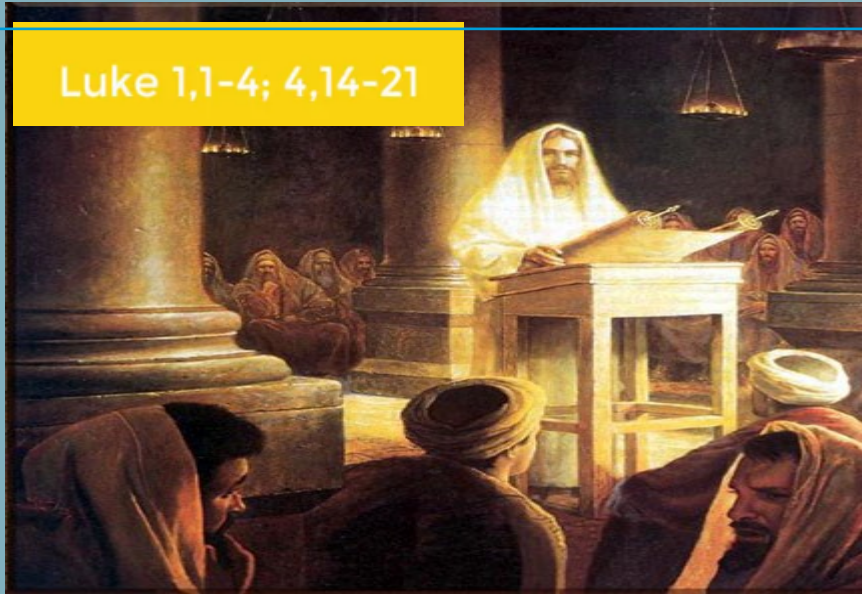

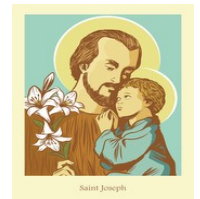

For we hold to be true that *God not only walks with His people, but also within them (Pope Francis)*.

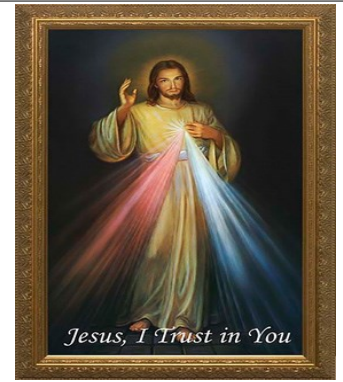

I have given myself over to His holy will; let Him do with me as He wishes, and I will still love Him. (Diary 589)
