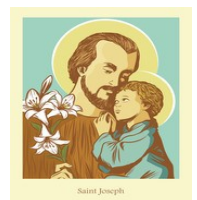

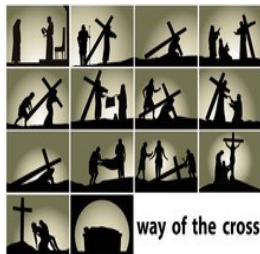

We pray that God will console and extend his grace upon all people who suffer regardless of their immigration status. For we hold to be true that *God not only walks with His people, but also within them* (Pope Francis).

Project Andrew for men ages 14-49

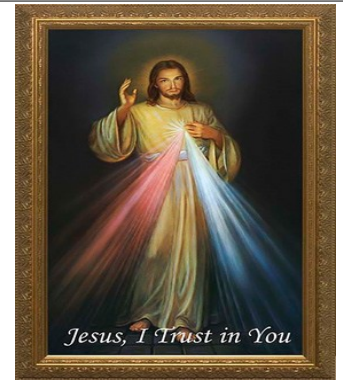

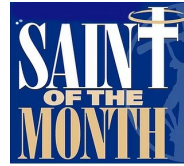

A Year of EUCCHARISTIC SAINTS

ST. FRANCISCO MARTO

Feast Day: February 20

Patron Saint of: Prisoners, Sick people, Bodily ills, those ridiculed for piety

In addition to following Mary's requests, **St. Francisco** had a devotion to "the hidden Jesus," Jesus hidden in the Eucharist. It was not uncommon to find Francisco in church (oftentimes when he should have been in school!) to comfort and console Jesus. As Sr. Lucia recalled in her memoirs, Francisco's favorite place to pray was by the altar – in order to be physically close to Jesus in the most Blessed Sacrament.

By his example, **St. Francisco** teaches us to thirst for Christ, to remain in His presence, and of the importance of consoling Him in the Eucharist simply by being present to Him. Additionally, St. Francisco challenges us to make visits to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament—even if it is for five minutes!



Además de seguir las peticiones de María, **San Francisco** tenía una devoción por "Jesús escondido", Jesús escondido en la Eucaristía. No era raro encontrar a Francisco en la iglesia (¡muchas veces cuando debería haber estado en la escuela!) para consolar a Jesús. Como recordó la Hermana Lucía en sus memorias, el lugar favorito de Francisco para orar era el altar, para estar físicamente cerca de Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento.

Con su ejemplo, San Francisco nos enseña a tener sed de Cristo, a permanecer en Su presencia y a reconocer la importancia de consolarlo en la Eucaristía simplemente estando presentes ante Él. Además, San Francisco nos desafía a hacer visitas a Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento, ¡aunque sea por cinco minutos!

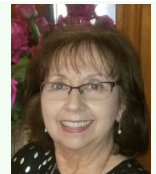
