

The take down and return storage in the Cooke House garage was set for Monday, January 6th at 4:30 pm and took about 30 minutes. Thank you all for your help!

From the January Council Meeting: GK Kenny Svrcek and members enjoyed Chili Dogs by Lecturer Dwayne David, and his helpers Marty Elman, Rodney Barcak, Special guests were Chaplain, Fr. John Boiko. GK Kenny reviewed the calendar for the remainder of January included the Rockdale Food Pantry delivery on the 17th and the Milano HS Senior Serve on the 25th. For February, there will be a Rotary Club Fundraiser on the 8th and Law Enforcement/First Responders Chili Supper on the 17th, and our popular (six Fridays) Lenten Fish Fry fundraiser in March and April. Discussion followed regarding bringing back the Mayfest Fundraiser this Spring which includes a raffle, auctions, BBQ meal and other activities. Also, only one meal choice (BBQ plates?) should be available. It was noted that the 1st Sunday in May, comes right on the heels of the six Fish Fry Fridays. A revamping of the six KC work crews is needed. Every crew is shorthanded. Rodney Barcak heads a committee to likely reduce the number of crews. Fr. John proposed, as a recruiting mechanism, periodically having KC members all attend a particular Mass and sit together giving the Knights a visible presence. Fr. John also wants to hold Ash Wednesday services at the KC Hall.
