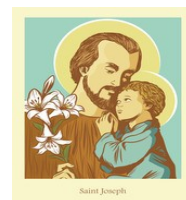

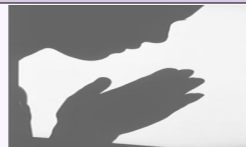

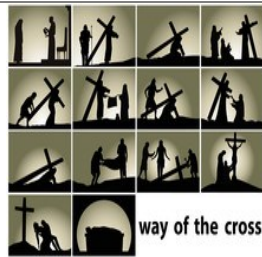

FRIDAYS DURING LENT –

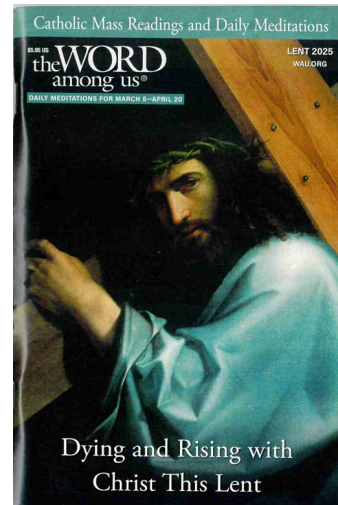
Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday in church at 6PM (English) and 7PM (Spanish).

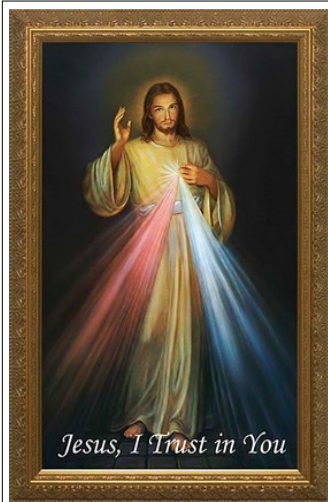

ST. CYRIL of JERUSALEM

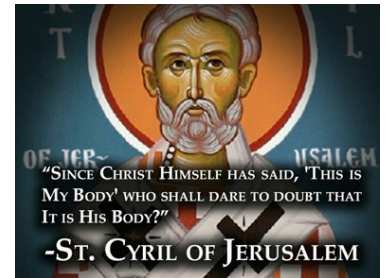
Feast Day: March 18

Patron Saint of: Catechists, Lecturers, Scholars, Theologians, Students, Brewers, Jerusalem

This exile lasted until Julian became emperor and recalled all exiled bishops, orthodox or Arian. So, **St. Cyril** returned to Jerusalem. When Acacius died, each faction nominated their own replacement for Caesarea. Cyril appointed his nephew Gelasius -- which may seem like nepotism -- except that all orthodox sources spoke of Gelasius' holiness. A year later both Cyril and Gelasius were driven out of Palestine again as the new emperor's consul reversed Julian's ruling.

Este exilio duró hasta que Juliano se convirtió en emperador y llamó a todos los obispos exiliados, ortodoxos o arrianos. Entonces, **San Cirilo**

regresó a Jerusalén. Cuando Acacio murió, cada facción nombró a su propio reemplazo para Cesarea. Cirilo nombró a su sobrino Gelasio, lo que puede parecer nepotismo, excepto que todas las fuentes ortodoxas hablaban de la santidad de Gelasio. Un año después, tanto Cirilo como Gelasio fueron expulsados de Palestina nuevamente cuando el cónsul del nuevo emperador revocó la decisión de Juliano.

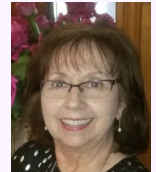

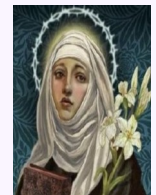
