

The Devotion consists of:

Going to Confession.

Receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion.

Saying five decades of the Rosary

Meditating for fifteen minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.

All of these can be done from 4pm-7pm on Saturdays as follows. August 2, September 6, October 4, November 1, December 6

On December 10, 2025 we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the request Mary made to preform this devotion. Start in August and end in December and fulfill Mary's request.

This is how it happened.....Our Lady's Request and Promise

While staying at the House of the Dorothean Sisters in Pontevedra, Portugal, Sister Lucia received a vision on December 10, 1925, where the Blessed Mother appeared alongside a Boy who stood over a luminous cloud. Our Lady rested one hand on the Boy's shoulder while she held in the other hand a heart pierced with thorns around it.

Sister Lucia heard the Boy say, "Have pity on the Heart of your Most Holy Mother which is covered with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment with no one to make an act of reparation to pull them out."

Examples of offenses against Mary:

Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception Blasphemies against her virginity Blasphemies against her divine maternity Instilling hatred in the hearts of children Insults against her sacred images

There are modifications to the requirements as follows: Confession can be done on a different day Exception if one forgets to make the intention A partial rosary is sufficient
