

great pilgrimage or to carry out some external ceremony; it suffices to come with faith to the feet of My representative and to reveal to him one's misery, and the miracle of Divine Mercy will be fully demonstrated (*Diary*, 1448).

This Saturday is the first Saturday of the month and time to continue the Five First Saturdays Devotion. The Devotion consists of:

- 1. Going to Confession,
- 2. Receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion,
- 3. Saying five decades of the Rosary,
- 4. Meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.

We do this all with the intention to make reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

This devotion is one of the major points of the message of Fatima, calling for reparation for the sins of blasphemy and ingratitude towards

the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

We do this all with the intention to make reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

What does that mean?

It means that we try to pull thorns out of Her Immaculate Heart. We try to make atonement and amends for our sins and those sins of our family members and friends.

Our Lord explained to Sr. Lucia how the Five First Saturdays correspond with the five offenses and blasphemies that mankind commits against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

First: Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception

Second: Blasphemies against her Virginity

**Third**: Blasphemies against the Divine Maternity, refusing, at the same time, to receive her as the Mother of mankind

**Fourth**: Instilling indifference, scorn and even hatred towards this Immaculate Mother in the hearts of children

Fifth: Direct insults against Her sacred images

Our Lady pleads for our prayers and we must listen to Her, and console the injuries and insults to Her and Her Divine Son.

This devotion is a great gift that was given to us not only for reparation, but also to protect our souls in the spiritual battles that we are in every day and at the hour of our death.
