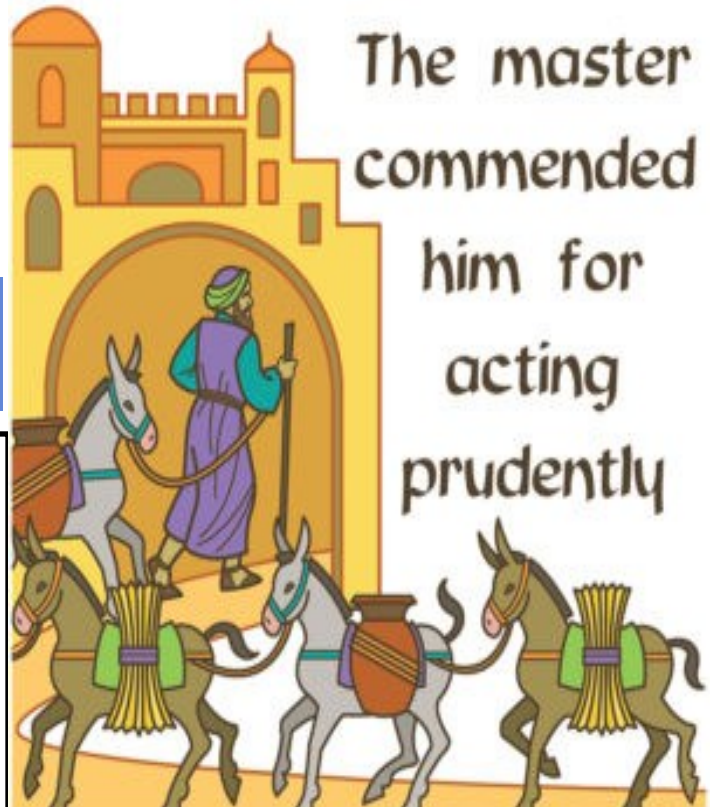

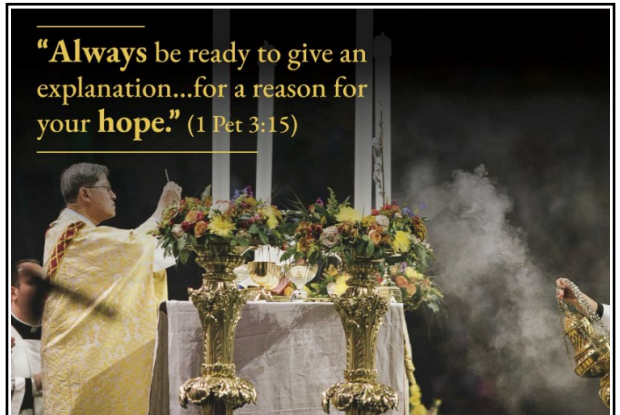
Students will process in, receive a blessing, and then sit with their family. The 9th graders will be in charge of the Mass.

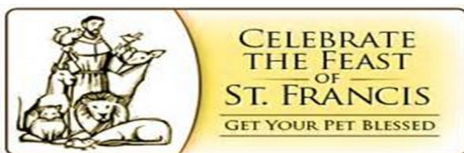

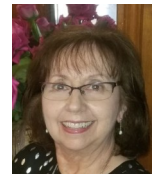
