

Elenor Gonzales, 83 of Tanglewood, Tx died on Aug. 25th in Temple, Tx. She was married to the late Bro. Santos Gonzales for 63 years. She was a member of St.

Joseph's parish in Rockdale and later Holy Family parish in Lexington, Tx after moving to nearby Tanglewood. Elenor, whose maiden name was also Gonzales, was born in Uvalde, Tx, into a migrant farm worker family on April 8, 1942. As soon as she was able to help, she traveled with the family following the harvests picking cotton in Texas, potatoes in Idaho and apples in Washington among many others. She attended over 17 different schools and was always behind in school. She managed to finish high school and graduated from Watsonville (CA) High School in 1963. At 18 she met Santos Gonzales, who was in the U.S. Navy and stationed in California. They married and settled in Rockdale. Santos worked at Alcoa and Elenor at Richards Memorial Hospital. They raised 5 daughters. Diana, Lydia, Helen, Maria and Linda, 16 grandchildren 29 great-grandchildren and 2 great-great grandchildren.
