




<u>A Year of First in</u> the Continent" SAINTS

ST. THOMAS (Asia)

Feast Day: July 3

Patron Saint of: Architects



While it was said that St. Mark is attributed to spreading Christianity to the continent of Asia, in truth, most traditions point to St. Thomas as having evangelized in India following Pentecost. Today, there is a devout community of Catholics on the Malabar Coast

of India who claim that their community began through the teachings of Thomas himself. From India, Christianity spread to Persia (modern day Iran), Central Asia, and China.

Saint Thomas, also known as Didymus or "the Twin," was born in Galilee, into a devout Jewish family. Not much is known about his family, but it is believed that he had siblings; and some non-scriptural writings refer to him as being a carpenter and perhaps a relative of Jesus.

Thomas received an excellent education, which allowed him to develop his critical thinking skills and broaden his understanding of the world. During his formative years, Thomas studied the ancient Hebrew scriptures, delving into the profound wisdom contained within. He immersed himself in the works of Jewish philosophers, theologians, and mystics, seeking to unravel the mysteries of the divine.
