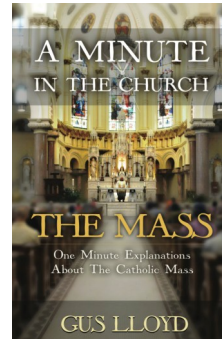

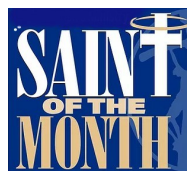

A Year of First in the Continent" SAINTS

ST. THOMAS (Asia)

Feast Day: July 3

Patron Saint of: Architects



As he grew older, St. Thomas began to develop a reputation for his sharp intellect & insightful interpretations of the scriptures. People sought his counsel and guidance, recognizing his deep understanding of the Jewish faith and his ability to articulate complex theological concepts with clarity. His life took an extraordinary turn when he was called by Jesus to be one of the twelve apostles. This marked the beginning of his apostolic journey, where he played a crucial role in spreading the teachings of Christ and shaping the early Christian community.

Saint Thomas experienced the miraculous appearance of the risen Lord, transforming his initial doubt into a profound declaration of faith. This personal encounter solidified his belief and motivated his lifelong commitment to spreading the Gospel.

St. Thomas' journey led him to India, where he established churches and communities, thereby planting the seeds of Catholicism in new lands. There are also some traditional accounts of him venturing to China and what is now Burma, Indonesia and Malaysia. Legends even exist of Thomas having evangelized Paraguay and Peru.

According to tradition, Thomas was martyred (speared to death) in Chennai, India, in 72 A.D., with the date of his death designated as July 3. Thomas was said to be buried there, but there are reports of some of his relics being taken to Edessa, Greece, and to Abruzzo, Italy.

In addition to Catholicism, Saint Thomas is revered among Orthodox Christians, the Assyrian Church of the East, Anglicans, Episcopalians, Lutherans and other Christians. In the Youngstown Diocese, St. Thomas the Apostle Parish in Vienna is named in his honor.
