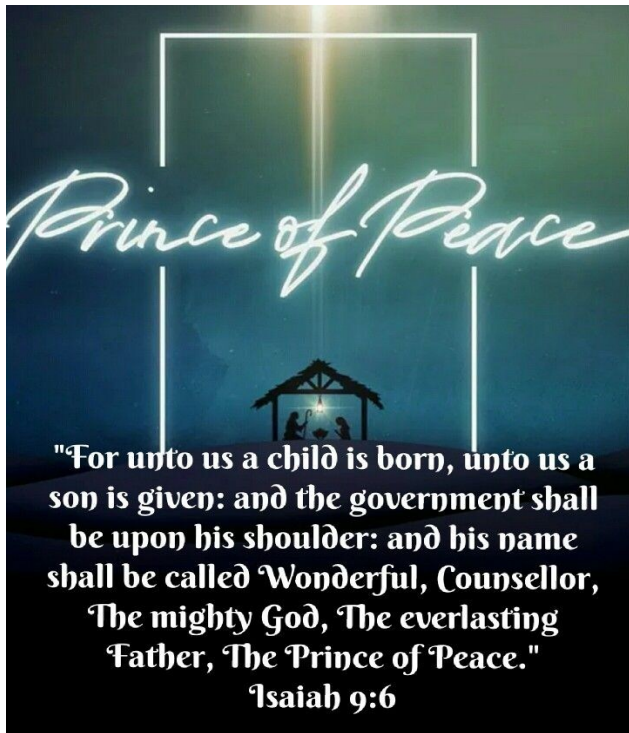
ST. MARK (Africa)

Feast Day: April 25

Patron Saint of: Venice

In 828, relics of **St. Mark** were stolen from Alexandria and taken to Venice, Italy. There they are enshrined in a beautiful cathedral dedicated to the saint. St. Mark's symbol is a winged lion. He is often depicted as writing or holding his Gospel. He is sometimes shown as a bishop on a throne or as a man helping Venetian sailors.

En el año 828, las reliquias de **San Marcos** fueron robadas de Alejandría y llevadas a Venecia, Italia. Allí se conservan en una hermosa catedral dedicada al santo. El símbolo de San Marcos es un león alado. A menudo se le representa escribiendo o sosteniendo su Evangelio. A veces se le representa como obispo en un trono o como un hombre que ayuda a los marineros venecianos.
