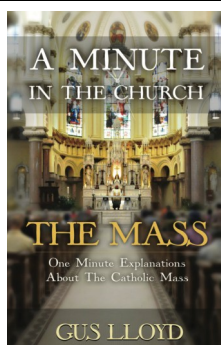

Joyful Recollection at the Holy Mass During the Midnight Mass of 1934

As Holy Mass began, I immediately felt a great interior recollection; joy filled my soul. During the offertory, I saw Jesus on the altar, incomparably beautiful. The whole time the Infant kept looking at everyone, stretching out His little hands. During the elevation, the Child was not looking towards the chapel but up to heaven. After the elevation, He looked at us again, but just for a short while, because He was broken up and eaten by the priest in the usual manner. His pinafore was now white. The next day, I saw the same thing, and on the third day as well. It is difficult for me to express the joy of my soul. The vision was repeated at the three Masses in the same way as in the first ones. (Diary, 347)

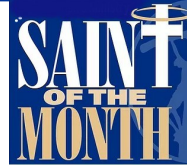

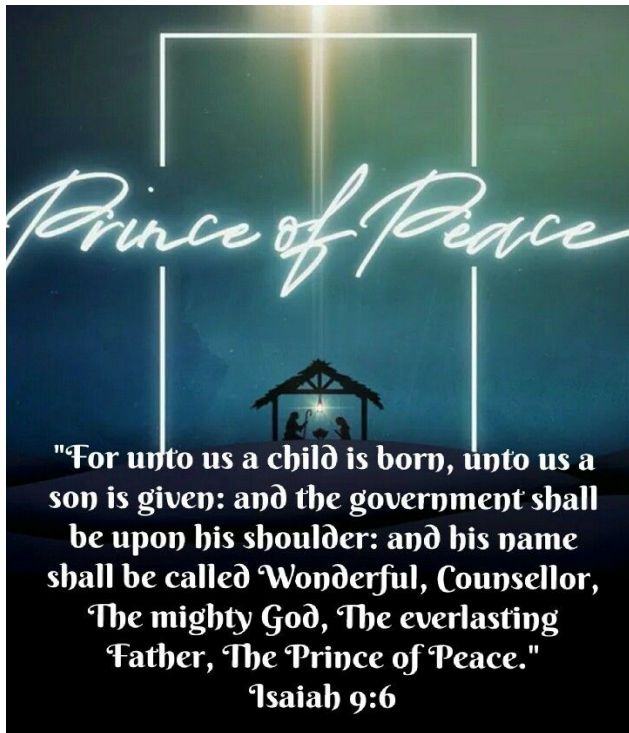
ST. MARK (Africa)

Feast Day: April 25

Patron Saint of: Venice

In 828, relics of **St. Mark** were stolen from Alexandria and taken to Venice, Italy. There they are enshrined in a beautiful cathedral dedicated to the saint. St. Mark's symbol is a winged lion. He is often depicted as writing or holding his Gospel. He is sometimes shown as a bishop on a throne or as a man helping Venetian sailors.

En el año 828, las reliquias de **San Marcos** fueron robadas de Alejandría y llevadas a Venecia, Italia. Allí se conservan en una hermosa catedral dedicada al santo. El símbolo de San Marcos es un león alado. A menudo se le representa escribiendo o sosteniendo su Evangelio. A veces se le representa como obispo en un trono o como un hombre que ayuda a los marineros venecianos.
