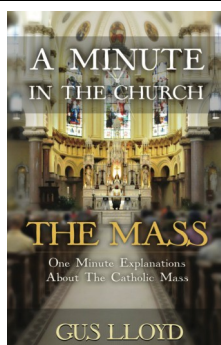

ST. ROSE OF LIMA (South America)

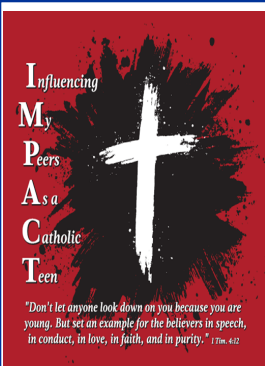
**Peru, S. America, Florists, Gar-

The Catholic Portuguese & Spanish Empires led to the Christianization of the indigenous populations of South America in the 15th century. The native peoples were required to accept the Spanish monarch's power over the region, along with Christianity. Catholic missionaries offered protection for the pre-existing slaves of the land, along with education for all.

St. Rose of Lima is credited as a major saint who spread the Catholic faith to South America.

Los imperios católicos portugués y español impulsaron la cristianización de las poblaciones indígenas de Sudamérica en el siglo XV. Los pueblos nativos fueron obligados a aceptar la autoridad del monarca español sobre la región, junto con el cristianismo. Los misioneros católicos ofrecieron protección a los esclavos que ya existían en la región, además de educación para todos.
