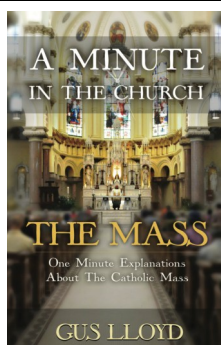

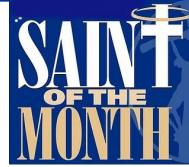

ST. KATERI TEKAWITHA (North America)

Feast Day: July 14

Patron Saint of: The Environment and Ecology

Christopher Columbus's second voyage to the new world in 1493 brought five Catholic priests to North America. Their goal was to evangelize the natives. However, the practice of human sacrifice practiced by the Aztecs stood in their way. It was not until 1521 that a full-scale conversion to Christianity began in North America.



El segundo viaje de Cristóbal Colón al Nuevo Mundo en 1493 trajo consigo a cinco sacerdotes católicos a Norteamérica. Su objetivo era evangelizar a los nativos. Sin embargo, la práctica de sacrificios humanos por parte de los aztecas se interpuso en su camino. No fue hasta 1521 que comenzó una conversión a gran escala al cristianismo en Norteamérica.
