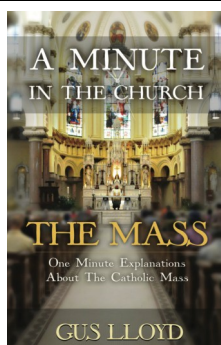

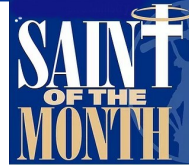

A Year of First in the Continent SAINTS

ST. ROSE OF LIMA (South America)

Feast Day: August 23

Patron Saint of:

Peru, S. America, Florists, Gardeners, Embroiderers



Born in 1586 in Lima, Peru to Spanish colonists, Isabel Flores de Olivia was so exceptionally beautiful, that she was nicknamed "Rose". And because her beauty was so often admired, Rose used to rub her face with pepper to produce disfiguring blotches.

From an early age, **St. Rose of Lima** wanted to become a nun. She often prayed and fasted in secret. She performed secret penances, some of which were painful and severe. She performed daily adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and took daily communion.

Nacida en 1586 en Lima, Perú, de padres colonos españoles, Isabel Flores de Oliva era de una belleza tan excepcional que la apodaron "Rosa". Y debido a que su belleza era tan admirada, Rosa solía frotarse el rostro con pimienta para provocarse manchas que la desfiguraran.

Desde muy joven, **Santa Rosa de Lima** deseaba ser monja. Oraba y ayunaba con frecuencia en secreto. Realizaba penitencias en secreto, algunas de ellas dolorosas y severas. Practicaba la adoración diaria del Santísimo Sacramento y comulgaba a diario.
