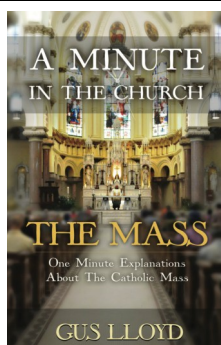

January 17-18 Pulpit Announcement (The Weekend Before)

Next weekend throughout the diocese is Called By Name Sunday; an initiative of the Diocese of Austin Vocations Office that celebrates God's call to each of us to follow Him in a particular way. Bishop Garcia has written a letter to us about this event, which we encourage you to read in our bulletin or social media pages. At every parish in the diocese, our priests will share the story of their vocation to the priesthood - how he listened and responded to God's call. As part of this special weekend, we are asking you to participate in two ways:

1) *** Pray for vocations. Our parish will be hosting a Holy Hour for Vocations on Saturday morning at _____. Please join us as we ask the Master of the Harvest to send out more laborers into his harvest.

(*** If your parish is not hosting a Holy Hour, read this paragraph instead:

Be open to God's call. For those who are able – be open the call to the priesthood or religious life. These vocations are beautiful gifts both to the Church and to those who are called. So be open, and be courageous if you hear the call.)

2) Spend time this week thinking about someone in our parish who God may be calling to the priesthood or religious life - someone with the qualities that you would want in your priest or religious sister.

When **St. Rose of Lima** turned 20, she was permitted to join the Third Order of St. Dominic. She continued a life of extreme prayer, fasting and penance. She was known to wear a heavy silver crown, with spikes that could pierce her flesh. The spikes reminded her of the Crown of Thorns.

So deep was her desire to live the life of Christ that she spent most of her time at home in solitude.

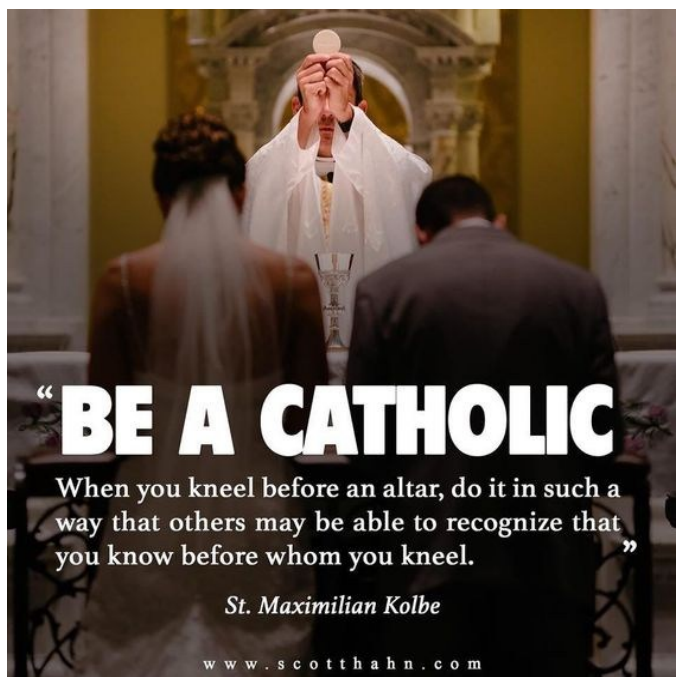
