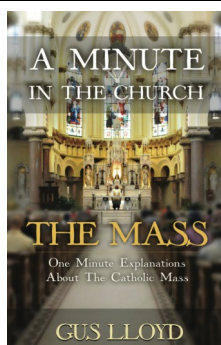

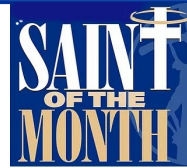

the Continent" SAINTS*

ST. ROSE OF LIMA (South America)

Feast Day: August 23

Patron Saint of: Peru, S. America, Florists,
Gardeners, Embroiderers

During the last few years of her life, **St. Rose of Lima** set up a room in the house where she cared for homeless children, the elderly, and the sick.

This was a beginning of social services in Peru. St. Rose died in on August 25, 1617, at the age of 31. According to legend, she accurately predicted the date of her death. Her funeral was a major event attended by all the city's authorities. Pope Clement IX beatified her in 1667 and Pope Clement X recognized her as a saint, canonizing her in 1671. She is the first saint from the Americas, and historians remember her for her piety and chastity.

Durante los últimos años de su vida, Santa Rosa de Lima habitó una habitación en su casa donde cuidaba a niños sin hogar, ancianos y enfermos. Este fue el inicio de los servicios sociales en Perú. Santa Rosa falleció el 25 de agosto de 1617, a la edad de 31 años. Según la leyenda, predijo con exactitud la fecha de su muerte. Su funeral fue un acontecimiento importante al que asistieron todas las autoridades de la ciudad. El Papa Clemente IX la beatificó en 1667 y el Papa Clemente X la reconoció como santa, canonizándola en 1671. Es la primera santa de América y los historiadores la recuerdan por su piedad y castidad.
