


ST. JOSEPH'S MAYFEST

ST. KATERI TEKAWITHA (North America)

Feast Day: July 14

Patron Saint of: The Environment and Ecology



St. Kateri was born in New York in 1656, the daughter of a fierce, pagan Mohawk warrior. When she was four years old, her mother died of smallpox. The disease also attacked Kateri and disfigured her face. She was adopted by her two aunts and an

uncle, and when she was a teenager, she converted to Christianity. She was baptized at the age of 20, to the great hostility of her tribe.

Santa Kateri nació en Nueva York en 1656, hija de un feroz guerrero pagano mohawk. A los cuatro años, su madre murió de viruela. La enfermedad también atacó a Kateri y le desfiguró el rostro. Fue adoptada por sus dos tías y un tío, y en la adolescencia se convirtió al cristianismo. Fue bautizada a los 20 años, ante la gran hostilidad de su tribu.
