

Feb. 21-22 -- First Sunday of Lent





ST. KATERI TEKAWITHA (North America)

Feast Day: July 14

Patron Saint of: The Environment and Ecology



*St. Kateri Tekawitha (1656 – 1680)
canonized October 21, 2012*

St. Kateri lived a life dedicated to prayer, penitential practices, and care for the sick and aged. Every morning, even in bitterest winter, she stood before the chapel door until it opened at four and remained there until after the last Mass. She was devoted to the Eucharist and to Jesus Crucified.

Devotion to St. Kateri is responsible for establishing Native American ministries in Catholic Churches all over the United States and Canada. St. Kateri died on April 17, 1680, at the age of 24, and is known as the "Lily of the Mohawks".

Santa Kateri vivió una vida dedicada a la oración, las prácticas penitenciales y el cuidado de los enfermos y ancianos. Todas las mañanas, incluso en el invierno más crudo, permanecía ante la puerta de la capilla hasta que se abría a las cuatro y permanecía allí hasta después de la última misa. Era devota de la Eucaristía y de Jesús Crucificado. La devoción a Santa Kateri fue la responsable del establecimiento de ministerios indígenas americanos en las iglesias católicas de todo Estados Unidos y Canadá. Santa Kateri falleció el 17 de abril de 1680, a la edad de 24 años, y es conocida como el "Lirio de los Mohawks".
