

Feb. 28-March 1 -- Second Sunday of Lent

This week we move from temptation in the desert to transfiguration and glory. Early in our Lenten journey we are given a hint of the resurrection. But first we must recognize the truth of St. Paul – that all of us are called to bear our share of hardship for the Gospel. Perhaps the mountain we must climb with Christ is one of sharing our time or ourselves with others. Perhaps we are called to greater simplicity of life and generous sharing of our material possessions. Each of us is called to die to self to live for Christ. What death must we die to share in Christ's glory?

The Melkites celebrate on this day the transfer into heaven of St. Joseph, spouse of the virgin Mary.

All the glories of Joseph derive from the fact that he is the foster father of Christ. That is why the Byzantine Church honors him particularly on the First Sunday after Christmas. In the first part of the nineteenth century, His Beatitude Maximus Mazloom, Patriarch of Antioch, Alexandria, Jerusalem, and all the East, introduced on this day another feast of St. Joseph to celebrate his transfer into heaven and his patronage: indeed, the example of his purity, prayerfulness, piety and humility is a powerful help for our spiritual life. He is also the heavenly Patron of engaged couples, an of all those who suffer temporal distress. St. Joseph probably died in the arms of Jesus and Mary. He now enjoys forever in heaven the beatific vision of the Word whose humanity he had so long and so closely contemplated on earth. He is rightfully considered the Patron Saint of a peaceful and holy death and model for contemplative souls.

The PURITY that made you stand out and the perfect innocence that shone forth from you, O just and most holy JOSEPH, have delighted the hearts of the faithful and shown us the way to angelic life and to the royal road. Wherefore the heavenly powers were amazed as they beheld the heights of your indescribable glory. We too sing a hymn to you: 'Glory to the One who honed you! Glory to the One who crowned you! Glory to the One who consecrated you as the intercessor for our souls!'

Because you loved purity of heart, you have become a close friend of the Heavenly King. Because He has chosen you to become the foster-father of his only-begotten Son, the ever-virgin Mary was entrusted to you as a pure bride, wherefore you received the choicest gifts of the Holy Spirit. O Holy JOSEPH, intercede for the salvation of our souls!





ST. MARY of the CROSS MacKILLOP (Australia)

Feast Day: August 8

Patron Saint of: Australia;

The Knights of the Southern Cross



Christianity was introduced to Australia with the arrival of the British First Fleet in 1788.

Reverend Richard Johnson, an Anglican chaplain, conducted the first Christian service in Sydney Cove shortly after the fleet's arrival. **St. Mary MacKillop**, also known as St. Mary of the Cross, was an Australian nun who is credited with the spread of Catholicism in Australia.


