St Joseph Mayfest Update

The Fundraising Committee wants to thank all St. Joseph parishioners who have picked up and are selling raffle tickets for our upcoming Festival. Your participation—whether selling tickets to family and friends or purchasing them yourself—greatly supports our parish fundraising efforts. Please remember to return ticket stubs and money in the envelope provided. Additional tickets are available at Mass or in the parish office. A \$200 gift card will be awarded to the person who sells the most tickets, and a \$100 gift card to the person who sells the Grand Prize ticket.

We are now focusing on preparations for the live and silent auction and other festival activities. Please prayerfully consider how you can help. 



In 1866, St. Mary MacKillop now took on the religious name "Sister Mary of the Cross," and her religious Sisters of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart founded a new school, at the request of the bishop. Their school was dedicated to the education of the children of the poor and became the first religious institute to be founded by an Australian.


